Reviewer Comments:

Reviewer #1:

1) Group is too small. Quantitative data potentially may not follow a normal distribution. The methods do not indicate whether the data conform to a normal distribution. The use of mean, standard deviation and parametric tests is not correct for non-normal parameters. If you have non-normal parameters, you must use non-parametric statistical methods and other data format (i.e. medians with low and upper quartiles). Results of this study may change after correcting of statistical analysis.

2) Everywhere you need to specify the exact values of P level to the third character after the separator, except for the case of $P < 0,001$.

Assistant Editor:

1) The imprecision in figures as regards quality, resolution and indistinctness do not support their publication in the present form.
