



LETTER OF INTENT FACULTY OF VETERINARY MEDICINE UNIVERSITY OF WIJAYA KUSUMA SURABAYA

AND

FACULTY OF VETERINARY MEDICINE UNIVERSITI MALAYSIA KELANTAN



With the objective of strengthening mutual cooperation as well as striving for the promotion of mutual exchanges, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Wijaya Kusuma Surabaya and Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Universiti Malaysia Kelantan have concluded the following intentions:

- Both Parties shall cooperate in the field of teaching, research and development in relation to but not limited to:
 - collaborate in research and development (R&D) as well as consultancy in relation to entrepreneurship, business and other forms of academic/social collaboration;
 - b. sharing of resources, facilities, knowledge and skills at the respective institutions for the purpose of teaching and research.
- The terms of specific areas of cooperation shall be further considered and agreed upon in writing by both Parties prior to the initiation of any particular activity.
- Any specific programme will be subjected to mutual consent, availability of funds and approval of both Parties.
- 4. The Parties agree that this Letter of Intent is not a formal legal agreement giving rise to any legal relationship, right, duties or consequences, but it is only a definite expression and record of the purpose of the Parties to which the Parties are bound in honour only.
- 5. This Letter of Intent will be effective when both Parties have signed and shall remain in force until termination by either Party giving the other party six (6) months' notice.
- The provision of this Letter of Intent may be amended at any time by the mutual consent in writing
 of both Parties.
